The Clothing Bank, Etc. proves clothing, household items and some furniture to families in the Vernon area. The Clothing Bank is operated by a team of volunteers who provide a variety of services such as:

- Sorting and hanging clothing
- Emptying bins in front of building

- · Re-stocking items as needed
- Helping clients check out

Hours needed:

Mondays and Tuesdays 10am-2pm – not open to clients- general stock work, sorting.

Wednesday 10am-2pm and Thursday 12-4PM- open to clients.

No volunteers needed Friday, Saturday or Sunday unless for a special event.

During the year, volunteers may be needed to setup and staff special events such as the Prom event, Back to School, Halloween store and Christmas Corner.

Volunteering at Clothing Bank, Etc. requires a significant amount of standing and may require lifting heavy bags of clothing. *All safety guidelines and procedures for Covid-19 will be followed including wearing gloves and masks and social distancing.*
